

Adult Faith Formation Coordinator

This position provides leadership in the design and implementation of programs for RCIA, young adults, and mature adults to assist in building a strong foundation for age appropriate spirituality, Christian living and service.

Tasks include ChristLife program administration, recruiting, assessing and supporting small-group facilitators, promoting and publicizing adult formation opportunities, and shepherding the formation of multiple small Christian communities. This position reports to the pastor.

Qualifications:

Degree in theology, education, human development, youth ministry, pastoral ministry, or related field.

This position comes under the Safe Environment Policy of the diocese which requires Act 33/34, DPW clearances, Protecting God's Children attendance certificate, a signed copy of the Code of Pastoral Conduct, and a signed copy of the Cardinal's clause.
